Mario Manzini deserves a "Thumbs Up" for his show. In spite of some weird lady who came out of nowhere trying to mess up his show, he pulled it off and did a Great show! He held the audience in the palm of his hand through out the show. He worked great with the children and the adults from the audience.

His escapes were the best. Like Houdini, he escaped from a straight jacket, 100 feet of rope tied to a chair, tied inside a canvas bag, wrist chain escape, and lots more. His finale was the Houdini water tank escape and he used volunteers from the audience to put him into everything that he escaped from.

His Phantom floating illusion was unbelievable. Dressed as the Phantom of the Opera with cape, mask, etc, he had his female assistant float way up in the air as he passed a hoop over her to prove that there was nothing holding her up in the air. We were seated on the side so we could see that there was nothing holding her in the air. Truly amazing. I never saw a floating illusion done like that. Really unique!

There was so much variety in the show besides his escapes. He did some as a mentalist, some magic with simple props like salt vanishing and reappearing from his hands with a lady from the audience. One that I liked was when some people were invited on stage. He asked the audience which one of them should be put into a straight jacket. He had the audience vote on it. Then the one chosen was put in the straight jacket by the other three and asked to try to escape which he couldn't do. It was hilarious to watch the man's face and movements trying to get out. Lots of fun!.

Then he gave up and was taken out of it and then the four people from the audience, there were 2 women and two men, strapped him in as tight as they could. One man even put his knee in Manzini's back to get the straps extra tight. Manzini then escaped in less than a minute without undoing any of the straps and buckles. Truly amazing. I guess this is what audiences witnessed when they saw the original Houdini in Vaudeville. I'm glad that I had a chance to see Manzini's stage show. I've seen many of the Houdini movies which were all great, but to actually see it live on stage in person. It was something that 'Il always remember.

He even had a child from the audience float in the air as he passed a hoop over him. I have never seen this done with some one from the audience instead of an assistant.

Also a policeman came up on stage and challenged Manzini to escape from his own handcuffs which he double locked on him and Manzinie escaped in 2 seconds wih everyone in the audience seeing how he did it. Amazing. Great show. Manzini was fabulous!

Mario Manzini's show was great. So much fun and excitement for the kids and adults. It was so much fun to see him performing all of his escapes and illusions.

Some of the best was when he invited lots of children and some adults to come up on stage so he could do some magic effects for them with them all assisting him.

He even had one of the children float in the air as he passed a hoop back and forth over him. That went over really good as he did it with a child from the audience and not using his assistant to float as most all magicians do. One trick that he did which was amazing. he had one of the adults on stage from the audience. He asked her to pick up a salt shaker form the table and unscrew the cover which she did. He then asked her to pour the salt from the shaker into his hand which she did. He closed his hand and opened it and all of the salt was gone. Vanished? Then he closed his hand again and opened it and the salt reappeared as he poured it into her hand? He did that

several times and she was right next to him and couldn't believe her eyes and neither could the audience. Great trick!

Another effect that he did was asking one of the adults on stage to think of a number, color, name or place. They wrote it down on a board with his back towards them. He then called out the name that they wrote down. He guessed it! That was mind boggling.

He had a great personality and it came across to the audience. For some of his magic he came off the stage and walked through the audience doing the magic with ropes and coins right in the audience close up.

One was where he was taking coins from children's ears while they were in their seats. Amazing.

He did several illusions. One was with a basket with a girl inside as he thrust lots of swords into the basket without harming her. Another was a large glass box that was empty and he made a girl appear in an instant. The floating illusion as the phantom of the opera was the best illusion in the show. Breathtaking with the fog, dungeon backdrop and colored lighting.

My real favorites though was all of his escapes which was what Houdini was known for. His publicity says that he is a Guinness World Record holder and we could see why. It was unbelievable the way he escaped from a very long rope tie to a chair put on him by adults from the audience. They got it as tight as they could and he escaped in less than a minute. Lots of excitement.

Other escapes were from a strait-jacket that they put on one of the adults from the audience. When he couldn't get out, they removed it and 4 adults from the audience strapped him in tightly. Again he escaped in less that 40 seconds.

The police officer's handcuff challenge was one of the best things in his show where a local police officer came up on stage during his show and challenged him to escape from his own personal handcuffs which he locked on him and Manzini escaped in a few seconds. That brought the house down as the audience cheered and many people even stood up and gave him a standing ovation for that.

There were many other escapes and magic, but these were the ones that I liked the best. We would very much like to see his show again. Very satisfied with him.

I saw the Mario Manzini stage show at the Genesee Theatre some time ago and didn't realize that I could write a review about it. Here it is.

He was Fantastic. He has a great personality on and off the stage. Very funny at times and very charismatic! He used almost total audience participation through out his show which was in 2 parts with an intermission.

There was a lot of comedy, magic tricks & illusions but the high lights were his Escapes.

His show is called a tribute to Houdini and it was.

We saw the Houdini mini series on TNT TV in Sept last year and Manzini recreated many of the escapes that we saw in the Houdini movie. But this was live on stage. Not TV or a movie. So it was really impressive to watch all of that from our seats in the theatre.

By the way the Genesee theatre was one of the most beautiful theatres that we have ever been in. I found out that it was built in the 1930s as a vaudeville-movie palace.

Manzini used old time vaudeville style back drops to enhance his show. With the stage colored lighting, fog machines, strobe lights and music it was really something to see.

Lots of the different illusions that he performed had different colored lights and he wore different changes of costumes. My favorite illusion was his floating lady done as the phantom of the opera with the costume, mask, green stage lighting, fog and music from the phantom show. It was breathtaking the way he had the girl dressed in the old fashioned white wedding gown and he wearing the mask & cloak. He hypnotized her and had her lay on a

red couch. She then began to raise up off the coach about 6 feet in the air. He passed a hoop back & forth over her that was handed to him by an assistant wearing a skeleton mask. Really Gothic looking and a great effect. We never saw any other magician present that illusion in that way. Unforgettable! The fog really added so much to that. It covered the entire stage and drifted off the front of the stage into the audience. Really great effect! The rest of the show was great. More Illusions. Having many children and adults come up on stage to assist him. He made those kids feel so happy as he worked with them. Very friendly.

One thing we couldn't understand was some woman kept running out on stage grabbing props. She didn't belong on stage and Manzini tried several times to have her removed but no one did. That was even very funny. Like Hellzapopin with Olsen & Johnson. My Grandparents told me that they saw that show on Broadway in NYC in the 1940's and I have a video of the movie.

His mentalism effects were amazing with people from the audience but his escapes were the best. Straightjacket, handcuffs, rope tying and a sack escape all put on him by people from the audience on stage.

One escape was a handcuff challenge by a local police officer who locked his own handcuffs on Manzini escaped in 2 seconds and gave the policeman back his handcuffs. The entire audience cheered Manzini as soon as he escaped. This was really unbelievable.

Anyhow I just wanted to give a review on Ticketmasters about Mario Manzini's show. We would like to see it again when he returns to the Genesee Theatre. Great family show for kids and adults.

Mario Manzini's stage show at the Genesee Theatre was great. I took my wife and 3 children to see it. We all loved it. We were told my some friends that also saw it that night that they just were notified by their friends that reviews could be written on here for anyone who saw his shows. They wrote one recently

Some people didn't like it and wrote some bad reviews, but the show was not bad at all. It was some weird lady that kept running out on stage many times trying to take over Manzini's acts. We could tell that there was something wrong with her as she wasn't wearing any costume and didn't know what she was doing. It seemed that she some how got back stage from the street. It was funny what she was trying to do many times but Manzini although he tried many times to get her off the stage without being able to, he still went on and did a great show. We liked his opening with the Snake Basket Illusion. The basket was on a base raised off the ground about 4 feet. He reached inside and grabbed 2 large very long snakes each about 8 feet long that were wiggling. They looked so real but I think they were rubber.

He ran down to the front of the stage and into the audience with a snake in each hand. All the women and children were screaming, but it was all in fun.

He then ran up on stage and dropped the 2 snakes into the basket as his girl assistant came out and got into the basket with the snakes.

He put the lid on the basket and then began to thrust 5 or 6 long swords into the basket from each side and then shoved a long broad sword about 6 feet long into the basket from the top to the bottom.

We could see the tip of the sword coming out of the bottom. Great reaction from the audience.

Then he removed the swords and removed the lid and the girl stood up and got out of the basket unharmed. Amazing trick. We couldn't figure out how she could be in that tiny basket all cramped down with out getting stuck by any or all of the swords.

Also the way Manzini did it. He was moving all over the stage as he shoved the swords into the basket like a bull fighter or flamingo dancer. Very graceful.

Another great Illusion was when he was handcuffed and tied in a bag and locked inside a wooden box by his girl assistant. She then started to tie the box up with rope as this crazy lady again came running out and grabbed the

rope from his assistant and started to try to tie the box up. She didn't know what she was doing and got the rope all tangled up.

Manzin's wife I believe grabbed the rope away from this lady and tied the box up herself as the crazy lady was trying to fight or push his wife away and finish it.

Manzini's girl assistant got on top of the box and pulled up a curtain in front of her and then dropped it to the ground revealing not her but Manzini free of the handcuffs, sack and locked box.

He quickly untied the rope, unlocked the locks and opened the lid. Up popped his assistant tied inside the sack wearing his handcuffs. We've seen this Illusion many times with other magicians and never get tired of seeing it again. But Manzini's presentation was exciting to watch.

Manzini did a lot of comedy magic with children and adults from the audience on stage and this went over really

The second act was even better with the Phantom floating illusion and all of his escapes from a straightjacket, rope ties handcuffs and chains.

The end of the show was the water tank escape. This was the big finish. Manzini was locked into handcuffs & chains and got inside the tank. As his wife started to lock the lid on the tank again this crazy lady came running out to the tank and grabbed some locks and started to lock him in the tank as his wife was doing that.

She was getting the lid on crooked and I could see that Manzini was choking on water as she was forcing his head down into the tank before he could hold his breath. He had to push up on the lid a few times to get air and then went all the way down in the tank as the locks were locked on.

Manzini's wife dropped the front curtain and took her place on the side. Right away this crazy lady ran over and pulled the curtain up all the way as Manzini was getting out of the tank so the entire audience saw him getting out and how he was doing it.

His wife grabbed the curtain and pulled it back down but it was too late. She yelled at the lady to get off the stage but she wouldn't.

That ended the show and when Manzini came out on stage we could all see that he was really upset and hurt for what this woman did to him.

But in spite of that he held the show together and did a great show. The audience all liked it and were talking with him after he came out off the stage. Everyone was asking him who that lady was and why she was doing that? We really enjoyed Manzini's show and look forward to seeing it again without that lady around.

This was so crazy as Manzini many times yelled back stage for some one to take this woman off the stage but no one ever did. It was almost comical at times.

Manzini then did a great show!
